## Parkside's landmark decision boost for the Foxlowe Arts Centre

ERICA BROOK reports that Peter Kent-Baguley, Chair of Foxlowe Arts Centre trustees, was invited by the trustees of the Parkside Centre Trust to attend their last meeting for the first hour to present an outline of the strategic plan for the Arts Centre and respond to detailed questions.

The Parkside trustees went on to discuss the matter and reached the unanimous decision to transfer the entire £170,000 funds of the Parkside Centre Trust to the Foxlowe Arts Centre in support of its planned purchase of the Foxlowe building.

Gareth Taylor, Chair of the Parkside Centre Trust, said: "I and my fellow trustees were really pleased with the outcome of the meeting and that Parkside was now supporting a centrally located venue, largely run by local volunteers."

"With the demolition of Leek Town Hall in 1984, the town lost its venue for theatrical events to an audience of 150-200 people. The Parkside Trust was set up to replace that. Our hopes for the Foxlowe are that, either by extending one of the rooms or by creating a new building, Leek will once again have a good performance space."

Gareth Taylor committed himself to continued support for the Foxlowe Arts Centre, including his willingness to help with fund raising and grant applications.

Fellow trustee and former chair of Parkside, Colin Broome, said: "The transfer of Parkside's assets of £170,000 was conditional on the purchase of the Foxlowe property, and

two trustees of Parkside joining the Foxlowe Arts Centre board of trustees."

Trustee and local councillor, Brian Johnson, also welcomed the outcome: "I wish the Foxlowe Arts Centre well, and that it goes from strength to strength, which in fact is already the case."

John Fisher, trustee and local councillor said: "I am very happy indeed about the unanimous vote of the Parkside trustees to support wholeheartedly the Foxlowe Arts Centre's efforts to purchase the Foxlowe. We must not, however, lose sight of Parkside's original goal of gaining a replacement auditorium." Cllr Fisher added: "Staffordshire Moorlands District Council originally earmarked £250,000 for Parkside, £50,000 of which went to support Museum developments, and that now that the Parkside Trust would be wound up, the Leader of the Council, should support the Foxlowe Arts Centre with monies allocated, but not spent."

While Peter Kent-Baguley should be thanked for facilitating this historic development the trustees of the Parkside Centre Trust, several of whom, have been valiantly involved for some twenty six years with Parkside, deserve the heartiest congratulations for their co-operative and far-sighted decision to support the Foxlowe Arts Centre, a creative, living community asset for Leek.
