Unveiling of dancing railings by Mayor & MP

Foxlowe Arts Centre patrons, Leek Mayor Cllr John Fisher and our local MP, Karen Bradley jointly unveiled the Dancing Railings along the end wall of the terrace at the Foxlowe on Saturday 8th June.

PM Training has been providing fantastic opportunities for young people in Leek to progress in further education and apprenticeships in particular. A recent example of this is when PM Training offered to provide an Artworks piece for Karen Bradley's constituency and she nominated the Foxlowe Arts Centre as the place for it to be showcased.

The Centre Trustees decided on a set of railings which would be functional but also have a strong element of design, fitting in with the general ethos of the Arts Centre.

PM Training then worked closely with local designer and Foxlowe volunteer Erica Brook. Erica worked with apprentice Dan Cutter to build a shared understanding of the materials and processes that could be used and based her innovative design on this which comprised dancing figures against a background of a Leek horizon. The project lasted around three weeks.

co-ordinator, Paul Butterworth, prepared the wall for the railings by removing the two courses of painted ugly concrete blocks and finished the resultant lower natural stone with sandstone flags. Although PMTraining's budget for the project was around £2,500, there was no charge to the Centre. PMTraining's artworks project manager, Phil Brown and apprentice Dan Cutter delivered and installed the railings.

Karen Bradley MP said: "I'm really pleased to see this fantastic piece of art in place. It's such an innovative way to show off the practical new skills the apprentices are learning at PM Training. And what better place than the Foxlowe to put it to demonstrate how individuals learning a new trade benefit us all. Well done Dan and Erica, and thank you to PM Training and all the Foxlowe volunteers."

Will Nixon, Chief Executive of PM Training, said: "As a local business we are keen to support our local community so were delighted to work on a project that combined the talents of young people with creating a piece of artwork for the Foxlowe Arts Centre."

Peter Kent-Baguley, chair of trustees said: "The railings are an excellent addition to the grounds of the Foxlowe Arts Centre. We are most grateful for PM Training's generous support, in terms of skills, finance and practical partnership working."
